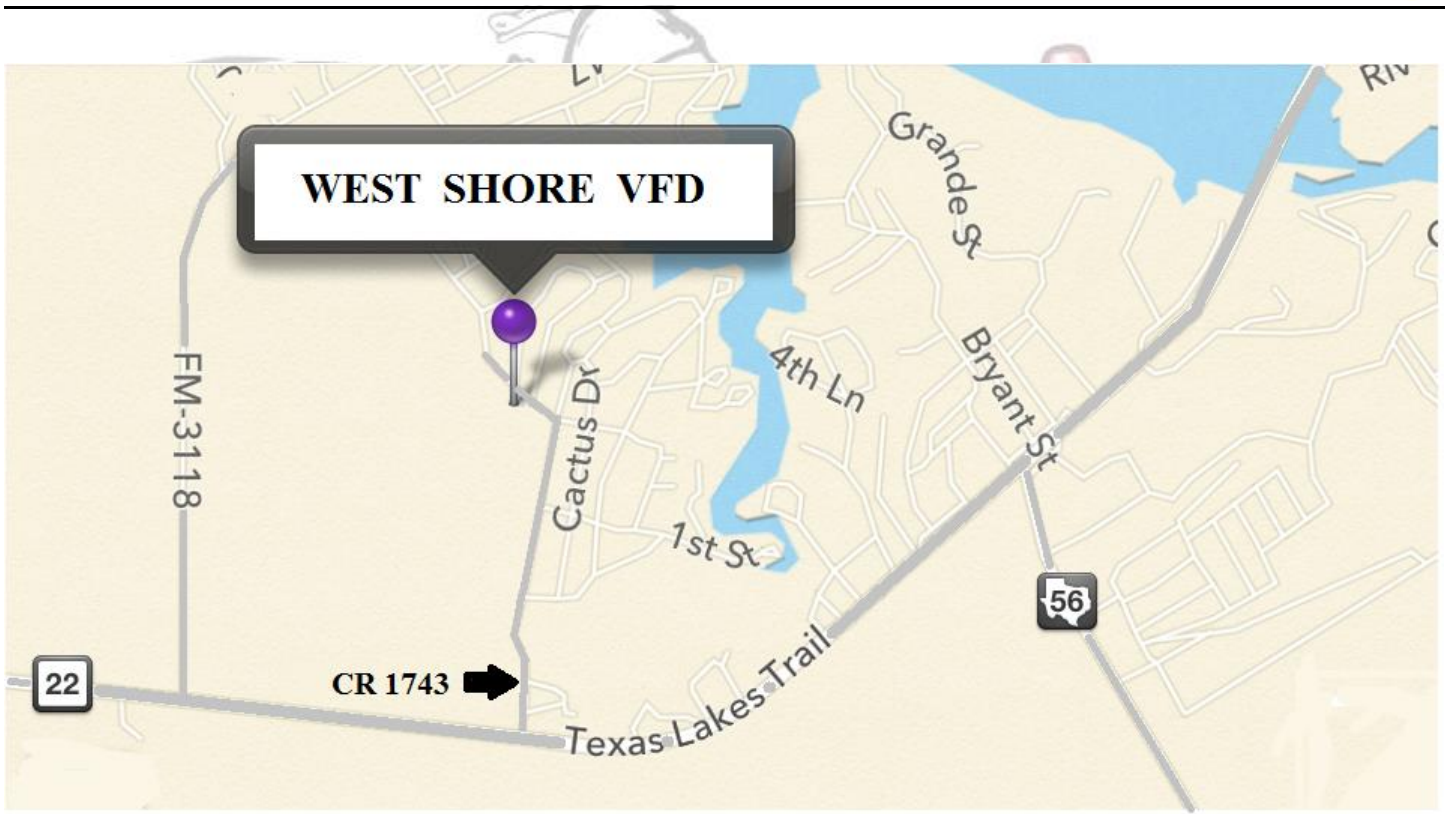
West Shore VFD BBQ Cook-off

April 12th – 13th, 2024 – Outlaw BBQ Association Sanctioned & Judged BBQ Cook-off Rules and Regulations

1. No One Allowed on Site until Friday morning 10:00am Gates open.
2. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to four (4) team members.
3. Any and all meat/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc, will not be allowed either on or off cook-off site prior to the start of the cook-off.
4. **Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start natural substance. (Not for full cooking) Holes or open pits are not allowed. Fires may not be built on the ground. Each team must bring a fire extinguisher. No fires are allowed using any type of treated wood or lumber. No railroad crossies, utility poles or treated lumber allowed.**
5. Props, trailers, motorhomes, tents, and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestants' assigned space.
6. **Ribeye Steak and Salsa entry can be prepared / cooked on site or at home. This is an open category.**
7. Beans – Dry Pinto Beans cooked on site. (Nothing larger than the bean to be put into the turn-in cup.)
8. Cooks Meeting will be held Friday night at 8:15 pm in the judging area.
HEAD COOKS MUST ATTEND!
 - A. Chicken Halves 1 separate ½ Fully joined chicken (to include wing tip, breast, leg and thigh)
 - B. Pork Spare Ribs 7 individual ribs (Minimum)
 - C. Brisket 7 full width slices- approx. 1/4" to 3/8" thick (Minimum)

Based on the number of cooks, turn in quantities are subject to change.
No garnish sauce is allowed in the tray at turn-in.
You may cook with sauce but it cannot be ladled onto the meat at turn-in.
9. It is the responsibility to the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean & that the area is cleaned and policed following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks & other materials or props hauled away & all equipment removed from site.
10. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Alcoholic beverages rules must be followed (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public. (
11. Promoters Call) No drinking glass containers or bottles allowed.
12. **Outlaw BBQ Association rules are Law.**
13. Promoter & cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.
14. **No golf carts, mules, utv /atv's or any other vehicles of this nature will be allowed on the cook-off grounds.**
(Cook-off official & security officers are exempt from this rule.)
15. All Profits go to the West Shore Volunteer Fire Department & other non-profit organizations to be used to benefit the Laguna Park community.
16. No live music or excessive loud music allowed in cook area.
17. No two (2) teams allowed to cook on the same pit
18. West Shore Volunteer Fire Department BBQ directors reserve the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules set by the Board of Directors
19. **"Quiet Time" will be 12:00 am – 7:00 am**
